Daily Bible Reading Guide

Week 10: March 6 - March 12

Our reading this week takes us to the preparations to enter into the promised land - the land which rebellious men had rejected, thus resulting in the 40 years of wanderings. We will then be reading for the next couple of weeks about the preparation for the conquest of this land.

Some questions to consider as you are reading...

March 6 – Numbers 26-27

- Who was not found among the people when they were numbered once again? Why?
- What did the daughters of Zelophehad request? Why, and why was their wish granted?
- When Moses was told that after seeing the land he would be “gathered unto thy people,” what was his concern? (27:12-17)

March 7 – Numbers 28-30

- What (in chapters 28-29) is said repeatedly to be “unto the Lord”? What does this tell us about worship?
- How much did Moses tell the people? (29:40)
- What was to be the actions of one who swore an oath to the Lord? (30:2)

March 8 – Numbers 31-32

- In 31:2 Moses is again told he will be “gathered unto” his people. Since his life was soon to end, how diligent was he in doing what the Lord commanded?

- What is recounted in chapter 33?
- What were the Israelites to do when they entered into the land of Canaan? Why were they to do this? What would happen if they did not do what they were told? (33:50ff)

March 10 – Numbers 35-36

- What were the “cities of refuge” to be used for and how were they used?

March 11 – Deuteronomy 1-2

- When did the book of Deuteronomy begin?
- When the people were told to go and take the land, why did they not do so? (1:26, 28, 32)

March 12 – Deuteronomy 3-4

- What was the value of obedience to the statutes and judgements of God? (4:1, 6)
- What warning was thus given in regard to the commands of God? (4:2)
- What two things were the Israelites to do to prevent forgetting the things their eyes had seen? (4:9)
- How does Moses describe God in 4:24? (Trivia - what television personality turned from Christianity when she heard a preacher say God was a “jealous” God?)
- How does Moses say that man got “upon the earth”? (4:32)
