Daily Bible Reading Guide

Week 12: March 20 - 26

Entering the promised land! It is hard to believe that our reading has taken us so far, and in this week’s reading we will see the entrance of God’s people into the land which He longed for them to possess. As you read, there are many lessons, but I hope we will always strive in our studies to keep our eye upon the prize – the hope – which God provides.

Some questions to consider as you are reading...

March 20 – Deuteronomy 28-29

- In the first 14 verses of chapter 28, how many ways, places, etc. can you find that God says He will bless His children? Was there a condition to His blessings being given?
- In verse 15 through 68, how many ways, places, etc. can you find that God says He will curse His children? What was the reason for such terrible things?
- In 29:1, 15, with whom did God say he made the covenant He was renewing?
- What is the purpose of the things which God has revealed? (29:29)

March 21 – Deuteronomy 30-31

- What would cause God to restore Israel (30:1-10)?
- How is it that the people could choose life or death? (30:15-20)
- How did God seek to have Israel overcome fear? (31:1-6)
- What was done with the law Moses had written? (31:24ff)

March 22 – Deuteronomy 32-34; Psalm 91

- Describe God (32:4; Psalm 91)
- What were the people to do with the law which was given unto them? Why? (32:46-47)
- Why was Israel to be “Happy” (33:26-29)?
- What was the cause of Moses’ death? (34:5-7)

March 23 – Joshua 1-4

- What land was promised to the people? (1:1-4)
- What was Joshua to do so that he could observe the law? (1:8)
